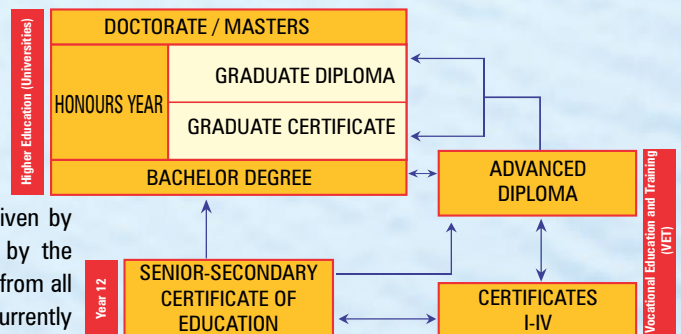
### Australian Qualification Framework (AQF)

In Australia every course offered in a university has a CRICOS Code which is given by Australian Government reflecting that the education system is fully controlled by the Government in Australia. There is no formal ranking of universities. Thus students from all around the world have long made Australia their education destination. Australia is currently home to nearly 746,000 international students until September 2023 Period.

## University

There are 43 universities ranging in size from around 3,000 students to 50,000 students - 39 of these are government run. Australian universities offer undergraduate and postgraduate programs in traditional and modern subject areas such as innovative courses in IT, Electronic Business and Science. Australian academics have won prestigious awards, including several Nobel Prizes, and are involved in ground-breaking research. As per QS world ranking 2024 The University of Melbourne, University of Sydney & University of New South Wales are in the top 20.

## Undergraduate Studies

Bachelor programmes may vary from 3 to 5 years. They are available across all faculties of Arts, Business, IT, Engineering, Health Science, Hospitalization and Science.

## Postgraduate Studies

Australia offers a wide variety of choices for post graduate studies. The individual universities offer different strengths and capabilities, providing a diverse base for research for students. Australian Universities pride themselves on a strong research base and state of the art equipment for their Universities.



## Vocational Education and Training in Australia (VET)

Australia offers a wide variety of vocational education and training courses. Each year increasing numbers of international students are choosing the TAFE option, either as a means of training and qualifying for a highly skilled job in business, the arts, or industry, or as an alternative pathway into university degree studies. The advantages for international students choosing to undertake TAFE studies are numerous but lower fees is one of the main reasons.

## Entry Requirements

### Undergraduate - Bachelors

- ◆ A good academic record in High School Certificate or 12 years of schooling
- ◆ Some courses such as Computing and Engineering will require Mathematics and /or Science as pre-requisites
- ◆ 6.0 IELTS / 79 TOEFL / 50-58 PTE

### Postgraduate - Masters

- ◆ A good academic record in Bachelors Degree from a recognized university is necessary
- ◆ Work experience in the field will be helpful
- ◆ For MBA programs at some Universities students need to have work experience along with their Bachelors Degree
- ◆ Masters & M.B.A. Degree for fresh Graduates available.
- ◆ 6.5 IELTS / 90 TOEFL / 59-64 PTE



## Application Procedure

Australia generally has two intakes i.e. February and July, with a few Universities offering multiple intakes in May, June, September & November. It is suggested that you should start making applications ideally 7-8 months prior to the intakes. University generally takes around 4-6 weeks to process the applications. Documents needed for making an application are resume, statement of purpose, marksheets and passing certificates from 10th onwards and current passport copy & IELTS / PTE / TOEFL score sheet.

## Study Costs In Australia

Australia offers the international student excellent value and high quality education at very competitive costs. International students are charged up-front tuition fees. These costs will vary depending on the course or institution, therefore, average costs are provided below and should only be used as a guide. Australian university fees vary from about A\$19,000 for a Graduate Certificate to A\$28,000 per year for a Graduate Degree. The more expensive courses usually have strong laboratory or computer components. Australia's vocational education and training providers offer a great variety of courses.

In spite of providing quality comparable to the best, the cost of education in Australia is comparatively much lower to that in UK and USA. Higher education in Australia provides value for money by offering shorter, more intensive courses than are available in other countries, thereby reducing living expenses.

## Living Costs in Australia

The average international student in Australia spends about AUD 29710/year on accommodation, food, clothing, entertainment, transport, international and domestic travel, telephone and incidental costs. While this is a realistic guide, it is important to remember that individual circumstances will vary by location, course and lifestyle.

## Types of Accommodation

- On Campus : College hostels (self catered or fully catered)
- Off Campus : Renting a flat / apartment
- Homestay : With the Families near the institution.
- Early application for accommodation arrangements are advisable.



## Part Time Employment

Students can work up to 48 hours per fortnight (anywhere) during course time and full-time during vacation on student visa. On an average a student can earn around 20-24 AUD/hour for casual / part time work.

## Health Insurance

It is compulsory for all international students to have Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for themselves and their dependants, where applicable, for intended period of stay. The premium for OSHC is to be paid once you accept the offer. The current cost for OSHC ranges between AUD 650-750 approx per annum depending on the duration of your studies.

## Aid and Scholarships

Most international students study in Australia on a full fee paying basis. There are, however, students undertaking postgraduate research in areas of particular concern to Australia who may apply for an Overseas Postgraduate Research Scholarships (OPRS). There are around 300 scholarships offered yearly to students from around the world. Individual universities occasionally offer scholarships or research grants for outstanding students. The Australian Government has an International Postgraduate Research Scholarship (IPRS) scheme for postgraduate research students. Part Scholarships available at Bachelors & Masters level on Academy excellence. Many Australian institutions offer their own scholarships. For details, refer to the institutions' handbooks, contact the institutions directly.

## Bank Loans

Both collateral / without securities Loans are available for higher studies. Interest varies from bank to bank. Contact the Loan desk at Edwise.

## Industries

Australian Industries work side to encourage and sustain the economic activity. The national income comes from industries like Mining, Education, Agriculture, Finance & Accounting, Hospitality, Manufacturing, Construction, Business services, Technology, Tourism etc.

## Post Study Work Right

- a) Bachelor and masters by Coursework, graduates who have spent at least two academic years studying that degree in Australia are eligible to receive three to six years Post Study Work Right, depending on province. Introduced on 16th November 2019, the new visa allows post-study work rights for international students up to 4 years in regional Australia
- b) Master by Research Graduates to receive three to six years PSW Rights
- c) PhD graduates to receive six years PSW Right.





## Visa Processing

- Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) has started a Online visa process which is faster with less evidentiary requirements.
- Australia follows a simplified Student Visa Framework (SSVF) arrangements, leads to simpler visa processing.
- All UG, PG, Masters, Masters by Research and PhD are assessed under subclass 500.
- Simplified Student Visa Framework (SSVF) leads to less evidentiary requirements for the Higher Education Sector.
- Reduced financial requirements up to 12 months irrespective of the length of program.
- Recent funds are accepted if source of funding with evidence is produced for review.
- Funds projected should be held with one or more of the listed financial institutions.
- Sponsorship should be within the family to fall in line with a positive profile.
- English Language tests besides IELTS are also accepted for student visa like PTE, TOEFL
- Course requirements must be satisfied with a valid eCoE
- Student can work upto 40 hrs per fortnight and full time during holidays and vacation.
- Student must maintain Overseas Health cover (OSHC) while in Australia.
- Unlimited work rights for Master by Research and PhD Student.
- Visa processing time 2 - 4 weeks under normal circumstances.
- Student can submit a visa file any time during, 120 days period prior to commencement of the program.



Even before a Student Visa is issued, there are certain requirements which must be met to the satisfaction of the Australian Authority abroad. The prospective student should :-

- Be accepted for a full-time course of study (registered by Australian Government for overseas students).
- Must meet Genuine Students Requirements (GSR).
- Have access to sufficient funds to cover tuition, living and travel expenses for the duration of their studies.
- Have adequate health insurance for the duration of your stay in Australia.
- Have reasonable proficiency in English through IELTS or TOEFL or PTE.
- Must obtain Offer Letters and Confirmation of Enrollments (COE) from the education provider.
- Have a current passport valid for a minimum of 6 months.
- Satisfy the health requirements as per the Australian High Commission rules.

## Work & Migration

Skilled - Graduate Visa is an 24 months visa given to students on completion of 2 years of Study in Australia. During this time the student can work full time, or improve their English to gain additional points for General Skilled Migrant Policy of PR

Skilled Graduate Visa Holders can apply for any of the following visa categories within the 18 months duration.

- Provisional Skilled - Regional sponsored visa (Subclass 487)
- Permanent Skilled - Independent visa (Subclass 885)
- Permanent Skilled - Sponsored Visa (Subclass 886)

Or they can also apply for an employer sponsored visa at any time.

### 1. How will Edwise International help me?

### 2. Are Credit transfers possible?

As the Australian Government recognizes Indian Universities, credit transfers are possible. However for this the students are required to submit their course syllabus to the institution and it can take minimum of 6 months for credits to be granted.

### 3. Are Australian Degrees recognized worldwide?

#### Why is GMAT and GRE not asked for by all Australian Universities?

Australian Universities are recognized worldwide. The reason why Australian Universities do not insist upon students going for a GMAT or GRE etc. is because these exams are for American Universities so students have to give these tests to be judged by American Standards. Australia and India recognize each other's degrees, However it may be asked by some Universities to assess the overall ability of the student.

### 4. How long does Visa application procedure require ?

The average time taken by the Australian High Commission for the visa procedure is anywhere between 4 to 12 weeks depending on the individuals background, so the students need to apply for their visas atleast 3 months prior to their course commencement.

### 5. How do you know which University is the best in Australia?

One cannot rate universities in Australia as there are numerous universities and all are regulated under the Vice Chancellors Committee, which follow the code of ethics. Students generally follow the market trends like MBAs or BBA, MIT etc., but it would be unfair to judge universities as one can only compare the course structure and faculty.

### 6. Can I find a Job placement after my course completion ?

With effect from 24th March, 2012 all students who have completed 2 years of study in Australia can get a Skilled Graduate Visa, whereby they can work for upto 24 months.

### 7. How do I know if I am eligible for the Permanent Residency (PR) ?

Currently a student needs to cover up to 60 points to become eligible for the PR, The points can be obtained by a combination of the following course, age, English language proficiency, duration of the Study in Australia, studying in a regional area, working part time. ### 8. What salary can i expect when i start working in Australia?

The average starting salary that you can earn is between A\$ 40,000 to A\$ 60,000 per annum.

### 9. My education has been in English. Do I still need to sit for IELTS ?

IELTS is a mandatory visa requirement. Also TOEFL & PTE is accepted.

### 10. What are the visa possibilities for my spouse/ dependent ?

Spouse /dependent of a Student- Visa holder in Australia gets a Dependent Visa and a valid work permit for the same duration as the primary applicant . This is applicable for Master's & higher degree applications.
